

SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET

CNC MACHINIST

The California Private Postsecondary Education Act (CPPEA) of 2009, which is effective January 1, 2010, requires under section 94910 of CPPEA that a school provide information for each program offered in regards to, completion rates, placement rates, licensure exam passage rates, and salary/wage information. - 1 "Number of Students Who Began Program" is the number of students who began the program who are scheduled to complete the program within the reporting year, and includes all the students who remained enrolled after their cancellation period."
- 2 "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students unavailable for graduation, which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active duty.
- 3 "Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.
- 4 "Completion Rate" is the number of graduates divided by the number of "Students Available for Graduation".
- 5 "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 101 - 150% of the program length divided by the number of "Students Available for Graduation".
- 6 "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 101-150% of the published program length divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation in the published program length period.
- 7 "Graduates available for employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment. "Graduates unavailable for employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- 8 "Graduates employed in the field" means graduates who are gainfully employed in a single position for which the institution represents the program prepares its graduates within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program.
- 9 "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of

graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment".
